TACKLING CORRUPTION THROUGH eGOVERNANCE IN UKRAINE



The USAID/UK aid Transparency and Accountability in Public Administration and Services/TAPAS project works with Ukrainian citizens, the central government and municipalities to improve public procurement, eServices and access to open data to help reduce corruption

Ukraine's Revolution of Dignity transformed the executive and legislative branches of government in 2014. Since then, the government of Ukraine has prioritized increasing public sector transparency and accountability through eGovernance reforms, including eProcurement, Open Data and eServices.

Transparent and open governments require readily available information about government operations and are more efficient due to reduced opportunities for corruption. Through the USAID and UK aid-funded Transparency and Accountability in Public Administration and Services/TAPAS project, Eurasia Foundation and its partners provide technical assistance and training that enable the government of Ukraine to implement visible and successful reforms in public administration and services to greatly reduce corruption.

Eurasia Foundation partners with leading Ukrainian nongovernmental organizations, including the East Europe Foundation, Kyiv School of Economics, Data Journalism Agency (TEXTY), Social Boost, Transparency International Ukraine as well as the Open Data Institute to implement this project.

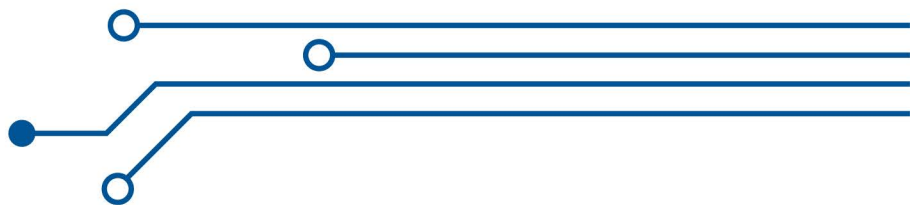

ePROCUREMENT:

Supporting the development of the public procurement ecosystem and professionalizing the industry to fight corruption in public procurement

OPEN DATA:

Supporting state and local governments in Ukraine in opening public data

eSERVICES:

Improving the efficiency and transparency of public services by transferring them into e-format

To achieve these results, the project engages directly with the Ministry of Economic Development, Trade and Agriculture, Ministry of Digital Transformation and Ministry of Health as well as local governments, educational institutions, technology companies, civil society organizations and the citizens of Ukraine.

Specifically, the project consults on procurement legislation, supporting training for procurement experts and

improving the IT infrastructure of Ukraine's innovative Prozorro eProcurement platform. It also encourages local governments and ministries to regularly publish data and sponsors an Open Data Challenge to foster innovation. Finally, the project supports the development and implementation of the National Interoperability Road Map and the transformation of public services into e-format.
